

Suprise project (Lisa)  The first stage of Valencia's ambitious Parque Central project has been unveiled, offering visitors an expansive green space by one of the city's most popular neighbourhoods. Following the relocation of high-speed trains below ground, Valencia's Parque Central is one of the city's most significant redevelopments to date. The 66-hectare site has received €73m of investment and will create a new contemporary public park which celebrates the culture of the region. This 23-hectare park will become the social heart of the city, uniting eastern and western neighbourhoods that were previously divided by the railway. Eventually it will also connect other areas of the city to a 43-hectare redeveloped Southern zone.
