

DIALOGUE CARD – SPACE FOR GIRLS

This card helps girls and professionals talk together about public spaces. We talk about what works well and what could be better. It is not about judging, but about sharing experiences. Everything you say is important. Take your time for the conversation (at least one hour).



CHECK IN: GETTING TO KNOW EACH OTHER

First, take some time to get to know each other. Who are you? Why are you here today? What do you know about this place? What does this place mean to you? Do you come here often?

Discuss the topics together. Decide how you want to use the card.
